The monthly meeting of the Democratic Party of Lane County Central Committee, held at the University of Oregon on Thursday evening, January 21, 2016, was called to order at thirty nine minutes past seven p.m., Mr. Wig being in the Chair and noting a quorum, and Ms. Swenson Harris present as Secretary.

The agenda was adopted as presented.

The Treasurer's Report was received. The Party had \$3,169.04 in income and \$6,858.63 in expenses during the previous month, with a net loss of \$3,689.59.

The Budget Committee reported that the Party had \$9,635.67 for the year and \$10,418.32 in expenses, with a net loss of \$782.65. Mr McClosky moved to approve the Party's Budget for 2016. Mr. Schneider seconded and the motion was passed unanimously.

The Campaign Services Committee reported that the Party will hire an organizer for the May election.

The Community Action Committee reported that the Party had a booth at the Eugene Asian Celebration on January 21 and 22. Ms. Heermance reported that the Party will have a booth at the Lane County Fair.

The Fundraising Committee reported that the Party's pancake breakfast will be held on March 19. Mr. Cronin asked for volunteers to help with the event.

The Organization Committee reported that 180 people filed to run as Precinct Committee People in the May election. Those who did not file will need to run write in campaigns or be appointed.

The Chair reported that two candidates have requested the Party's endorsement for the position of District Attorney. Both candidates will be considered for endorsement at the April Central Committee Meeting.

The SCC Delegation reported that the DPO Platform Convention was held on March 6 in Portland. Ms. Gillpatrick reported that the DPO's Wayne Morse Gala will be held on April 2 in Portland and that the SCC meeting will be held on April 30 in John Day.

The 4th CD Delegation reported on candidates running for the State Legislature in the 4th Congressional District.

The Chair reported that Chairs are needed for House Districts 7, 13, and 14 and for the Fundraising and Rules Committees.
