The Campaign Services Committee reported on the May election and on Democratic candidates who will appear on the ballot in November. Ms. Mooney reported on the Party's work to support local campaigns in West Lane, Springfield, and North Eugene.

The Community Action Committee reported on the Summer Civics project, signature gathering for IP 25, and on the Party's participation at the Rhododendron Festival and the Lane County Fair.

The Fundraising Committee reported that fundraising letters will be sent in conjunction with summer events. Mr. Cronin reported on the Springfield Spaghetti Slam, to be held on September 21 at Willamilane.

The Organization Committee reported on House District organizing in support of candidates in the May election. Ms. Heermance reported that the Precinct Committee Person elections will be certified June 8.

The Platform Committee reported that a resolution relating to Our Children's Trust will be considered at the Committee's June meeting.

The PR Committee reported that the Party's election night party was a success. The Committee will begin work on a new logo and website.

The SCC Committee reported that the State Central Committee meeting will be held on June 9 and 10 in Pendleton.

The 4th CD Delegation reported that the 4th Congressional District will meet in Coos County on July 8. .
