The monthly meeting of the Democratic Party of Lane County Central Committee, held at the Eugene Garden Club, on Thursday evening, April 18, 2018, was called to order at twelve minutes past seven pm, Mr. Wig being in the Chair and noting a quorum.

income for the year and \$12,408.23 in expenses, with a net loss of \$2,779.45.

The Community Action Committee reported that the Party will host a self care seminar. Ms. Leseney reported on the Florence Rhododendron parade.

The Organization Committee reported that the volunteer form has been updated.

The Subcommittee for PCPs reported the names of previous nominees requesting to be appointed to the position of Precinct Committee Person: Colin Lyons and Joel Iboa were appointed.

The Fundraising Committee reported on planning for the Party's summer events and the Roosevelt Gala. Planning meetings will be held on May 5 and May 10.

The PR Committee reported that the committee is working on new button designs for sale in the office and at summer

events. Ms. Keizer encouraged Campaigns to submit information on upcoming events to the Party calendar.

The Rules Committee reported that a bylaws review will be conducted after the May election.
