

# DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF LANE COUNTY

## Central Committee Minutes

6/17/2021 – Teleconference

The monthly meeting of the Democratic Party of Lane County Central Committee, held via teleconference, on Thursday evening, June 17, 2021 was called to order at fifteen minutes past six pm, Ms. Gillpatrick being in the Chair and noting a quorum and Ms. Swenson Harris present as Secretary.

The agenda was adopted as presented.

The minutes were approved as presented.

The Treasurer's report was received. The Party had \$18,212.15 in income and \$11,032.22 in expenses for the month, for a net gain of \$7,179.93.

The Campaign Services Committee reported that all payments for campaign services in the May election have been received.

The Community Action Committee reported on the Blue River Book Drive. Ms. Bradvica reported on the Party's Lane

County Fair, Asian Celebration, and Pride Booths.

The Fundraising Committee reported on planning for the Chili Cook Off and Roosevelt Gala. The Committee is tentatively planning for an in person Chili Cook Off in August. Ms. Keizer reported that the Roosevelt Planning Committee will meet on July 12 and that auction donations are still needed. Ms. Hammond reported that the Party is working on a wall calendar and is requesting photos.

The Organization Committee reported on the Neighborhood Leader Program. The Committee is working to update the PCP Guide and will meet regarding the Organization Committee tow year plan.

House District 8 reported on the Neighborhood Leader Program. Neighborhood Leader recruitment is ongoing.

House District 9 reported on the Florence Democrats Neighborhood Leader

participation. The Florence Democrats will be participating in Florence Indivisible support for the For The People Act, the Florence Organizer's Juneteenth Celebration, and the Florence 4th of July celebration. The Florence Democrats Annual Picnic will be held August 8.

House District 11 reported on neighborhood leader organizing. Nine neighborhood leaders participated in the program, with 42% of voters in their turfs returning ballots.

House District 12 reported on Neighborhood Leader participation and the District's postcard campaign. House Districts 11 and 12 will meet on June 27 at 4pm.

House District 13 reported on the Neighborhood Leader Program and turf maps.

House District 14 reported on outreach to Neighborhood Leader participants.

The Subcommittee for PCPs reported the names of people requesting nomination for the position of Precinct Committee Person: Laura Greenley, nominated by Ms.

Henjum; and Gabii LeGatte nominated by Ms. Swenson Harris

The Subcommittee for PCPs reported the names of previous nominees requesting to be appointed to the position of Precinct Committee Person: Orion Deschamps, Shannetta Mennenga, and Bryan Haynes, were appointed.

The PR Committee is requesting that upcoming community events be sent to the committee for inclusion on the Calendar .

The State Central Committee Delegation reported that the SCC will meet on June 27. The State Party expects to hold an in person meeting in the Fourth Quarter, along with the State Platform Convention.

The 4th Congressional District Delegation reported that the Congressional District Committee will meet on July 18.

Ms. Swenson Harris provided an update on the County Redistricting Process.
