Central Committee Minutes

11/17/2022 – *Eugene Garden Club, 1645 High Street Eugene*

The monthly meeting of the Democratic Party of Lane County Central Committee, held at the Eugene Garden Club and virtually, on Thursday, November 17, 2022, was called to order at 6:30 p.m., Ms. Swenson Harris being in the Chair and noting a quorum and Mr. Kounovsky present as Secretary.

The agenda was adopted as presented.

The minutes were approved as presented.

The Treasurer's report was received. The Party had \$16,513 in income and \$13,405 in expenses in October, for a net gain of \$3,108.

The Budget Committee reported that plans are underway for the 2023 budget.

The Campaign Services Committee reported on the 2022 election results.

The Community Action Committee reported on ongoing community partnerships and our work with nonprofits.

The Fundraising Committee reported that plans are underway for 2023 fundraising efforts.

The Organization Committee reported on the results of the Neighborhood Leader Program with great success of all neighborhood contact methods with 94 volunteers. There will be an upcoming Organization meeting on the 17th of December.

House District 7 reported thanking all the Springfield neighborhood leaders.

House Districts 9 and 10 reported that the Florence Area Democratic Club is planning an election recap.

House District 12 reported on the results of the 2022 election with 16 neighborhood leaders.

House District 13 reported on the efforts of the HD 13 neighborhood leaders with 27 volunteers who contacted over 630 voters.

House District 14 reported that their neighborhood leaders had strong contacts with their neighbors.

Jennah Litecky Yost was nominated by Andrew Ross and seconded by Dakota Boulette. Mary Ann Peterson was nominated by Celine Swenson Harris and seconded by Dakota Boulette. Rebecca Bradvica moved to appoint PCPs by acclamation, seconded by Elise Josephson. Jesse Maldonado and Ibrahim Coulibaly were appointed unanimously.

The Rules Committee had nothing to report.

The State Central Committee Delegation reported that the upcoming meeting will be December 3 and 4 in Milwaukie.
