Central Committee Minutes

5/18/2023 – Eugene Garden Club, 1645 High Street Eugene

The monthly meeting of the Democratic Party of Lane County Central Committee, held at the Eugene Garden Club and virtually, on Thursday May 18th, 2023, was called to order at 6:41 pm, Ms. Swenson Harris being in the Chair and noting a quorum and Mr. Kounovsky present as Secretary.

The agenda was adopted as presented.

The minutes were approved as presented.

The Treasurer's report was received. The Party had \$3,569 in income and \$10,425 in expenses for the month, for a net loss of \$6,677.

The Campaign Services Committee reported on the results of the May election with many successes of election or reelection of Democrats, and that the Eugene Ward 7 race appears to be headed to a fall runoff.

The Community Action Committee reported that the Civics Carnival was a major success and had a lot of visitors, and that the committee is going to be doing a lot more events over the summer.

The Fundraising Committee reported that the Ice Cream Social will be July 16th at the Campbell Center from 1-3pm.

The Organization Committee reported that the Neighborhood Leader Program was very successful and made a difference in the election, with many thanks to the HD Chairs supporting them.

Nominations for PCP were Alexander Aghdaei nominated by Elise Josephson and seconded by Brendan Sanders, Erick Oshel nominated Elise Josephson and seconded by Andrew Ross, Janean Fossum nominated by Katrina Bowser and seconded Karl Eysenbach, and Anevay Simonsen nominated by Katrina Bowser

and seconded Karl Eysenbach. Sara Wolk and Doniya Boyd were appointed as PCPs, which passed unanimously.

House District 7 reported that they will be meeting on May 23rd.

House District 8 reported that NLP was successful despite some technical glitches.

House Districts 9 and 10 reported that it was a difficult election cycle, but their volunteers worked very hard.

House District 13 reported that their Neighborhood Leaders were very successful in the election outreach.

The Platform Committee reported that there is planning going on for the SCC Platform Convention, and preliminary planning for the DPLC Platform Convention.

The PR Committee reported that they are gearing up for promoting summer events.

The Rules Committee reported that we are awaiting rulings from the DPO regarding caucuses.

The State Central Committee Delegation reported that there is a meeting May 21st in Le Grande.

The 4th Congressional District Committee Delegation reported the next meeting will be June 24th.

As New Business, the Kick-Ass Award was presented to Larry Koenigsberg for outstanding work volunteering for the DPLC.
