24	proposing endorsements of legislation and resolutions consistent with the DPLC

The Treasurer shall not issue reimbursements except as authorized by the Executive 50 Committee or Central Committee except that the Treasurer may issue 51 reimbursements from the petty cash fund with the approval of the Chair. No 52 request for reimbursement shall be considered unless presented to the Treasurer, 53 54 in writing, prior to the incurring of the expense. k. k. Where the Treasurer is informed of expenses incurred, more than ten days after 55 the expense occurred, and the expense was not approved by the Executive 56 Committee, Central Committee or the Chair and Treasurer, then the Treasurer shall 57 regard that expense as having occurred independently of the Democratic Party of 58 59 Lane County. 60
